The Fayette Raleigh Metropolitan Planning Organization (FRM) is performing a traffic study to evaluate the issue of traffic “cutting through” the Maxwell Hill area using Pikeview Drive, Holliday Drive, Pinewood Drive, or other similar routes through the residential area to travel from Harper Road to US 19 near the Beckley Shopping Center. The goals of this study are to better define the problem and evaluate potential transportation solutions to the specific issues.
